This initiative focuses on monitoring and improving water quality in our local area.



Earlier this week the group has been actively surveying water quality at Port Eynon, learning how to collect water samples, and contributing to important data on winter water conditions. This is a fantastic opportunity for our pupils to engage with real-world environmental issues and make a meaningful difference in their community.
