


Newyddion - Friday 21st February 2025

Communications/ Payment solution update

Following our recent announcement about Squid withdrawing from the UK, we have decided to transition to IPayImpact as our new online payment system. As a result, we will stop using Squid from this Friday.

IPayImpact is already used for our school dinners, so most of you already have an account. For those who don't, you will receive an email from Mrs Hughes Morgan with details. The good news is that **IPayImpact now has a user-friendly app**, which we have been testing, and it makes purchasing quick and easy!

We kindly ask all parents to **download the app** and ensure their children are set up before returning from half term. Full instructions and FAQs can be found on our website here: www.knelstonprimary.co.uk/school-communications.

A key difference from Squid: Unlike before, both parents can now be linked to one child, allowing each to create their own login, contribute to payments (e.g., school trips), and view the total balance. However, individual payment history will remain private.
